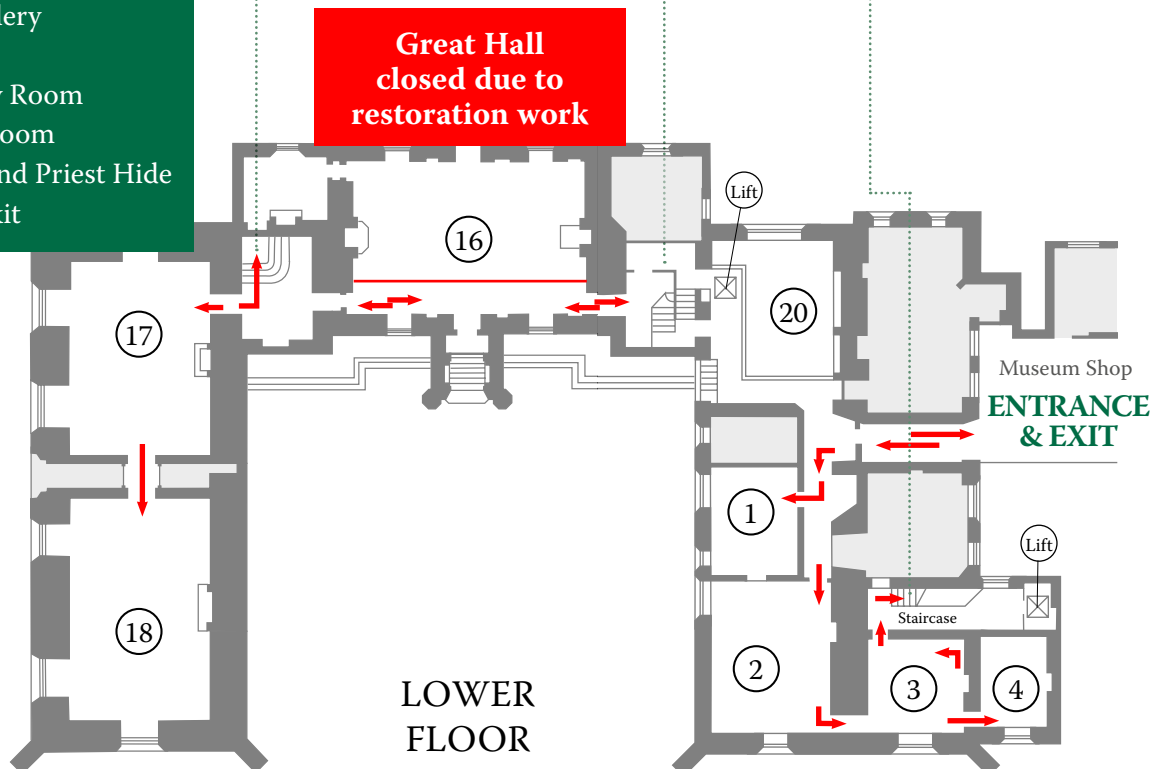
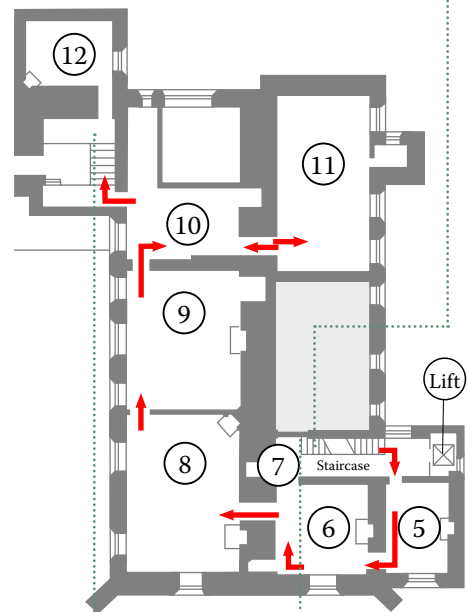
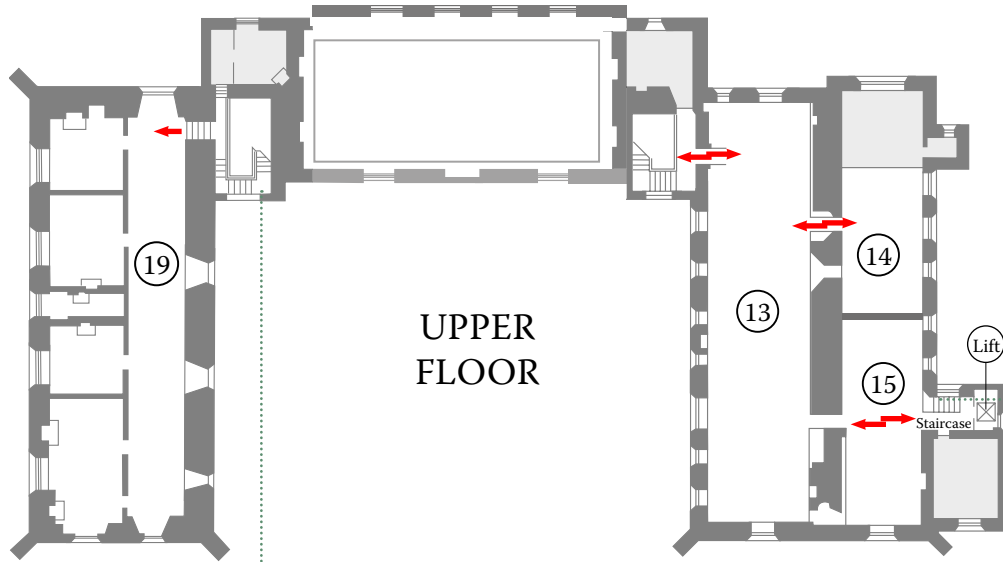
### **Restoration Works to the Great Hall & Art Galleries**

During our period of closure staff have been busy working on essential maintenance to the hall, ensuring its place in Burnley's history for another 600 years. Currently this means the

Great Hall is closed whilst we undertake surveys and repairs to the Grade I listed ceiling. Although the Great Hall is closed a protective corridor is in place to give visitors full access to the South wing.

The Art Galleries are now open, following completion of repairs to ceilings above the Jacobean staircase. Towneley is proud to present a new exhibition: **Evelyn De Morgan Pre-Raphaelite Artist of Hope**. De Morgan's paintings and sketches give an insight into the Pre-Raphaelites and the prestigious Slade School of Fine Art.
